GENERAL INFORMATION:

Ferti-Manganese 500 is a source of Manganese for plants. It can be added to liquid fertilizers or can be used alone or in combination with a regular preplant liquid program.

Rates of application will vary according to Manganese deficiencies in each crop. Do not apply at rates higher than recommended levels.

Ferti-Manganese is specifically formulated for addition to polyphosphate fertilizers. One-half to one gallon per acre will usually correct most trace element deficiencies.

SOIL APPLICATION:

Apply 1-8 quarts of Ferti-Manganese 500 per acre alone or in combination with liquid fertilizer for preplant, starter, or side dress applications. Vary rate according to Manganese deficiency and soil condition.

ORDER OF ADDITION TO LIQUID FERTILIZER

1. Add Polyphosphate
2. Add Manganese
3. Add Nitrogen and Potash

Do not add to aqua ammonia or solutions containing excessive amounts of free ammonia.
